The relationship between the Client and the Company shall be governed by these mentioned terms, as amended from time to time.

The Client accepts and understands that the official language of the Company is the English language and that he should always refer to the legal documentation posted on the website of the Company for all information and disclosures about the Company and its activities.

INTRDOCUTION

Stemming from our core values of "Trust and Confidence", ProFX Ltd makes every effort in order to safeguard and protect personal information provided by our Clients via our website.

1. COLLECTION OF PERSONAL INFORMATION

1. ProFX Ltd is entitled to ask for personal details of its Clients in order to comply with statutory rules and regulations as well as to serve our customers effectively and efficiently.
2. The requested information may include: customer's full name, proof of address, date of birth, contact numbers, email address, passport number/or ID number, marital status,



government issued photo ID with client's signature, financial information like client's annual income, liquid assets, net worth, previous trading experience and risk tolerance.

3. ProFX Ltd may also collect some personal information about the use of our services.
4. This might be information by which each Client can be identified such as: the times of logging on, volume of services provided types of data, systems and reports the Client accesses, locations from which a Client logs on as well as duration of visits and other related information.

2. PURPOSES OF COLLECTING PERSONAL INFORMATION
